

UNIBO: International Mobility

One of the most internationalised among Italian universities:

- Around 5000 foreign students regularly enrolled (5,7% vs national average 2,9%)
- More than 3000 exchange students
- More than 2000 outgoing students
- 34 international MA programmes: joint/double degree, Erasmus Mundus Action 1 (6 MA; 2 professional masters; 3 PhD). 11 out 34 taught in English.
- Active participation in EU funded projects for higher education (Erasmus Mundus, LLP, Tempus, ALFA, EuropeAid funded projects, FP7, etc.)




